

**San Francisco Republican Party (SFGOP) Resolution (2017-002)**  
**Resolution on the Joint Terrorism Task Force**

---

**WHEREAS**, in March 2017 the City and County of San Francisco suspended participation with the FBI's Joint Terrorism Task Force (JTTF);

**WHEREAS**, the JTTF working in conjunction with San Francisco law enforcement allows for better counter-terrorism and crime prevention than either entity can provide as a sole entity;

**WHEREAS**, shared resources and intelligence work in favor of all participants;

**WHEREAS**, city departments need to work with other government public safety partners in multi-discipline exercises, such as Urban Shield, in preparation for a disaster that will require additional non-San Francisco resources;

**WHEREAS**, training with all participating federal and state agencies before a disaster is necessary to most effectively save lives during a real disaster;

**WHEREAS**, because San Francisco is an international target for terrorism, it would be negligent of the City and County if it does not train and work with all parties that will be coming to the aid of San Francisco citizens during an actual emergency;

**BE IT RESOLVED, THAT**, in the name of public safety for all San Francisco and Bay Area residents and businesses, the SFGOP urges the Mayor, the Board of Supervisors, the San Francisco Police Commission, and the San Francisco Chief of Police to renew the City and County's partnership with the JTTF.
